We are a non-profit organization with a parent nongovernmental organization. Founded in June, 2018, we work on the United Nations sustainable development goal 4: Quality Education.


Our aim is to enhance educational opportunities presented to underprivileged kids.

- Select a skill that meets their needs
- Procure the required sponsorship & volunteers to conduct the workshop
- Get the material & Conduct the Event. After event final budgeting is closed.

VOLUNTEERS & SPONSORS

Sponsors pay for a single event or workshop conducted by us. If required, they receive the entire budget and a letter of acknowledgement. They are taught the required skills before they from the organisation where the event is conducted as well as from Idhant. Typical sponsorship is around INR 1,500 to INR 2,500.

Volunteers can commit to either a single or a series of events.



WHAT WE DID



ELOCUTION WITH A THEME OF ETHICS AT DSMP VIDYALAY: 16 MARCH, 2019

WHAT WE DID

Idhant introduced a unique workshop that had a fun and quirky curriculum. Idhant organised an Elocution Event, with the theme of the day: Ethics for the kids of the government school, DSMP Vidyalaya. This was an innovative workshop with the theme of moral responsibility cultivation in the kids. We decided to impart moral science skills in the form of skits, stories and interactive sessions. A group of teaching volunteers was trained and their tasks included:

- 1. Helping the kids complete their small activities and quizzes.
- 2. Aiding the kids in English speaking during skits and speaking activities.
- 3. Encouraging the kids to take part in active discussions.

The event was divided into 2 sessions. The sessions included:

Session 1: Introducing the concept of Moral behavior and story narration

Session 2: Ask the kids about their dream and skits on moral topics.

Along with these topics, road signs were also taught to the kids and at the end of the session, paper craftorigami box was taught.
